In July 2020 the government announced catch-up funding for every school stating “Children and young people across the country have experienced unprecedented disruption to their education as a result of coronavirus (COVID-19).

How we will spend the money

- Staff additional small group sessions for children to support in English and Maths.
- Appoint a teacher one day a week to support small groups of children in Key Stage 1.

How the effect of this expenditure on the educational attainment of pupils will be assessed

- Baseline and ongoing termly summative assessment will be used to track progress.
