This year, instead of dressing up as book characters, we are inviting the children to come to school dressed as an **"Amazing Adjective."** This links closely to our work in class and encourages children to think about how words can describe people, feelings, and ideas.

Children can choose **any adjective they like** and dress in a way that represents it. This can be simple and does **not** need to involve buying anything new. Using clothes, colours, or accessories you already have at home is perfect.

Here are a few ideas to help inspire you:
